Notes:

While not a Buddhist anniversary, the legends of how the twelve animals were chosen for the Chinese horoscope suggests that these were the first to respond to the Buddha's call to for all animals of the world to gather to him, arriving in the order that they appear in the calendar i.e. Rat, Ox, Tiger, Rabbit, Dragon, Snake, Horse, Sheep, Monkey, Rooster, Dog and Pig.

Vesak: also Tibetan Saka Dawa - Theraavada - celebrating historical Buddha's birth, eath and enlightenment

Vassa - Rain's Retreat start (Theravada) / Obon & Ulambana - Ghost Festival (Japan)
